Half of the donations collected remain within the Annual Conference to provide hope to children and youth, hope for a brighter future in impoverished communities and a voice to those who have felt voiceless for years.

NJFON supports and empowers a coalition of 20 JFON sites around the country that work to welcome immigrants and refugees by providing legal assistance that aspiring residents need but cannot afford or access. Through JFON's attorneys, they help immigrants understand their choices and navigate the complexities of the legal system.

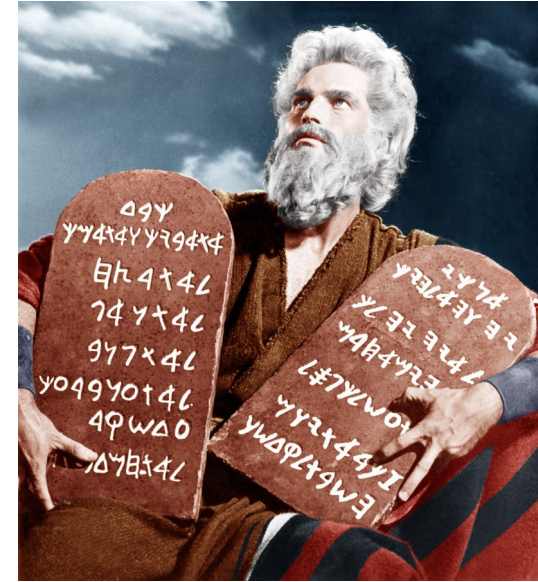


Messy Church is church, but not church as you know it! It is a way of being church for all ages to join in experiencing fun and faith formative activities.
